Love to music

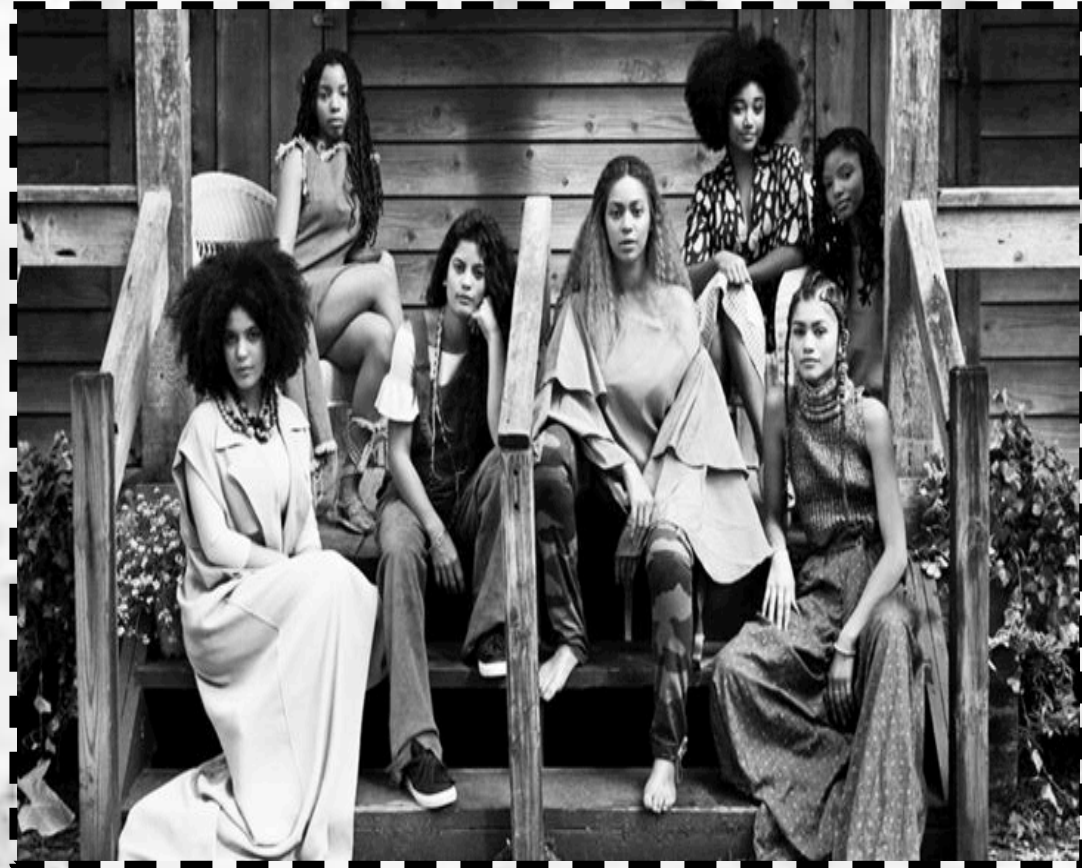
