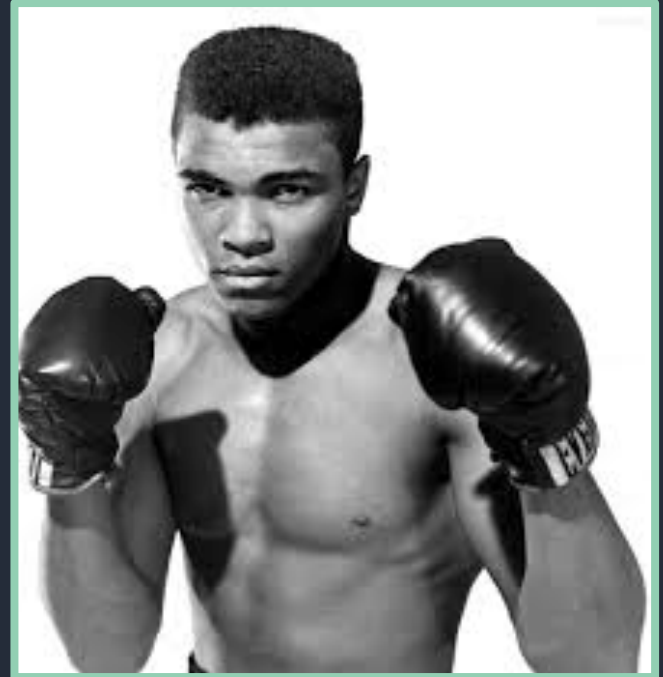


Muhammad Ali

Story of Muhammad Ali

Muhammad Ali (his first name was Cassius Clay) was born in Louisville on the 17th January 1942, he was an American boxer and he's been the best of all time. His father died before he was born.



Historical Context

He lived during the Vietnam War. Muhammad Ali was an important person for the Muslims community because in a speech he said: "War is against the teachings of the Qur'an." During this war he refused the military service.



Work of Muhammad Ali

He won six Golden Gloves.

After his career as an amateur he made a name for himself: in 1960 he participated to Rome Olympic games winning the gold in the light heavyweight category. His final amateur record was 100 wins and 5 losses.



Style of fight

His fight style was “fly like a butterfly, punch like a bee”.

He had other technique to punch: stay near the ropes not to knockout and to soften the punch.

He died in Scottsdale on the 3rd of june 2016 for a septic shock.
