there is (c'è) = contracted, there's. Negative: there isn't. Question: is there?

there are (ci sono). Negative: there aren't. Question: are there?

There is, there are used to say that something exists or does not exist.

(si usano per dire che qualcosa esiste o non esiste).

example: There is a book on the table. There are a lot of children.
